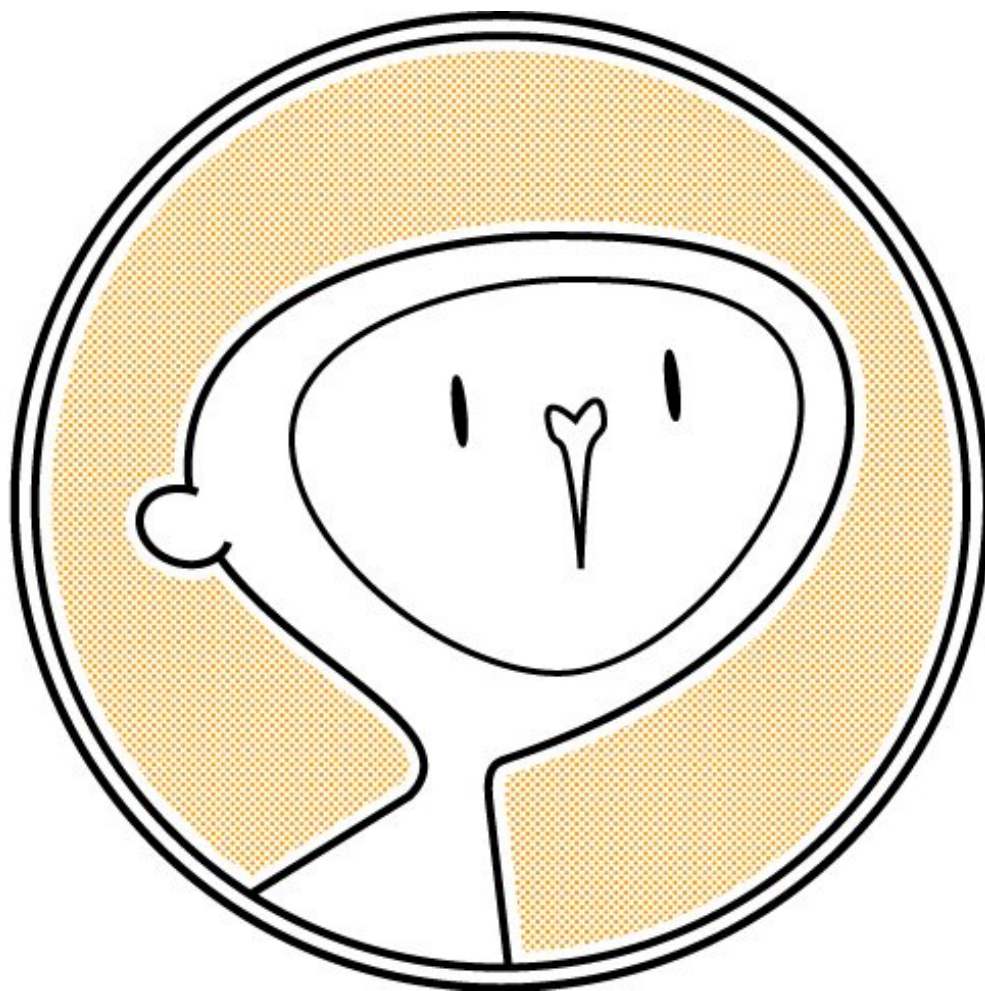

Rules:

Please take note of your game rules below!

Saturday

A 1-16, B 1-8, W 1-4: **90min, 2pt cap, game to 15**

B 9-16, W 5-8: **90min, 1pt cap, game to 15**

C 1-11, W 9-16: **75min, 2pt cap, game to 13**

Sunday

A 1-16, B 1-16: **90min, 2pt cap, game to 15**

W 1-16, C 1-11: **70min, 1pt cap, game to 13**

EXCEPT: W 1v4, 2v3, 1v2, 3v4: **90min, 2pt cap, to 15**

EXCEPT: W 13v14, 15v16: **90min, 1pt cap, to 15**

EXCEPT: C9v11, 9v10 in round-robin: **90min, 2pt cap, to 15**

Other game rules:

90min games have two timeouts per team per half (8).

70min games have one timeout per team per half (6).

Games are to **13, win by two**, hard cap 15; or to **15, win by two**, hard cap 17 - depending on the division. The hooter causes the hard cap to be reduced to two (or one) above the highest score at the end of the point.

Sudden death occurs only when teams are tied at one point less than the hard cap.

Games to 15 have 2min half at 8, games to 13 have half at 7.

Extra play, etc

Extra play occurs at 12-12 in games to 13, and at 14-14 in games to 15.

Once in extra play both teams have exactly one time-out, regardless of the number of time-outs taken in the game so far.

Basically, you either win-by-two, or win by hitting the hard cap first.

Tour 2008 is being played under the WFDF 2007 ruleset.

Notes:

1) Priority has gone to teams not having to move around inbetween games, with A, W and B Tours getting the best pitches if possible. Back-to-back games happen (you should never have to travel far for one), though three back-to-back in a row do not.

2) The C Tour is an open format, so any team can finish in any position.

3) On approval from the women's teams, women's board, and the competitions committee, we are running a 'Super Peer Pools' schedule for the Women's Division (again) this Tour. The aim of this is to provide much tougher, tighter games to all teams, all weekend, whilst not compromising movement between positions too greatly.

4) As 3rd place in the B Tour is not a qualification spot, the GTG Semis have been removed from the T3 schedule.

5) Although it looks unlikely, in case of rain, pitch 1 games may be moved to free slots on pitch 8, so as to preserve the ground for the final.

6) C Tour 9-11 games after the group stage are a round-robin, so you retain your seed between them. Some C Tour group games are played on Sunday morning.

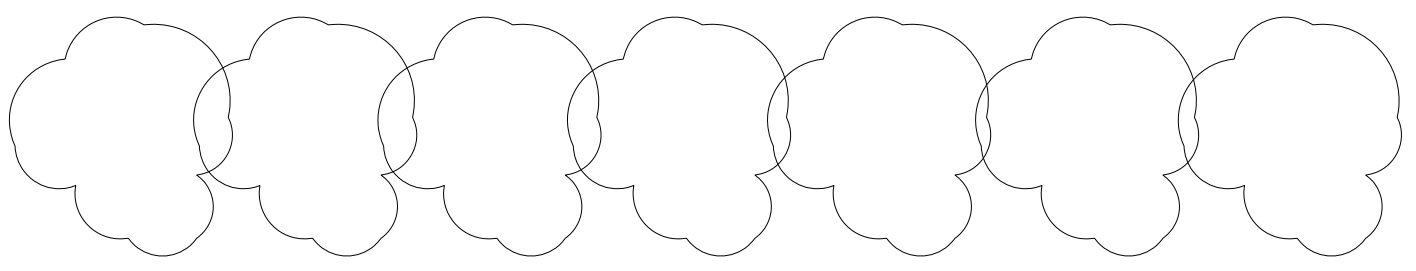

Located near Ollerton, on the edge of historic Sherwood Forest, this 150 acre park is one of Nottinghamshire's most popular visitor attractions. At the heart of the park are the picturesque remains of a 12th century Cistercian monastery and later country house. Around them lie gardens, meadow and woodland. The attractions of Rufford range from a contemporary **craft centre** with gallery exhibitions and 'potters in residence' to peaceful walks around the lake.

Enjoy your visit

There's plenty to do all year round at Rufford. Enjoy a tasty cooked lunch in the Victorian-style Savile Restaurant, relax over a coffee in the Coach House Café or browse in the Lakeside Garden Shop. Visitors welcome!

Browse around the **Visitor Centre** shops or relax after a stroll in the Forest Table Restaurant. Take a walk to the mighty **Major Oak**, pick up one of our fun family nature

trails, or just stand and admire the weird and wonderful shapes of the ancient oak trees, twisted by age and weathered into living sculptures.

Take time out to appreciate the unique ecology of **Sherwood**. The natural decay of fallen wood means the woodland teems with insect life, fungi, birds and bats. In partnership with the **Sherwood Trust**, we currently have a woodland grazing project at Sherwood, with Hebridean sheep and Dexter cattle helping ensure that open areas of medieval heath land do not revert to scrub.

Sherwood Forest Country Park welcomes around 500,000 visitors each year, ranging from local residents to overseas tourists, from special needs groups to school outings.

Home of a legend!

Sherwood Forest has a fascinating history and is the legendary home of Robin Hood.

Ancient woodland

This 450 acre country park was designated a **National Nature Reserve** in 2002 by English Nature, the Government agency responsible for safeguarding our natural environment. Visit their website at: www.english-nature.org.uk.

The site is managed by us and maintained by our country park rangers, working to a Woodland Management Plan drawn up as a partnership between English Nature and ourselves.

Sherwood Forest Country Park contains some of the oldest trees in Europe, veteran oaks five centuries old and the world-famous **Major Oak**, still producing acorns after standing at the heart of **Sherwood Forest** for an estimated 800 years!

How to Find Us



Watermeadows is on Bath Street, which is approached from Nottingham Road, or the ring road (St Peters Way). Directions are provided by brown tourist signs. There is a pay and display car park directly outside, of which the ticket value is redeemed when you use the facility (in 50 pence denominations, up to a maximum of £2.00). If using public transport, the 737, 747 and 757 buses (for Nottingham) pass by the complex. The train and bus stations are about a 10 to 15 minute walk. Why not make a day of it by visiting Mansfield's other attractions?

There's something for everyone at Sherwood Forest and you can do as much or as little as you like.

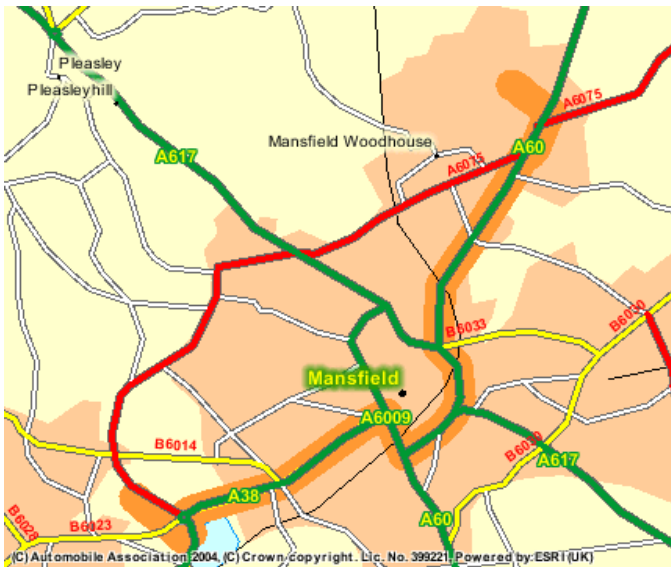
