


Venue

Location

Mixed Tour 2 will take place at the University of Nottingham's Grove Farm playing fields. The venue doesn't have its own postcode, but **NG7 2SA** will get you onto the right entry road.



Directions

Nottingham is roughly 2.5, 3 and 5 hours drive from London, Cardiff and Edinburgh, respectively, with 80% of the UK within 2 hours of the city.

Nottingham is best accessed from the M1 for the majority of the country, or via the M5 & M42 for those travelling from the West. Whether taking the M1 for long distances, or joining it at the end of the M42 or M6, your best bet is to exit at Junction 24 (regardless of being Southbound or Northbound), onto the A453. Follow this road along the River Trent for around 10 miles, before reaching the A52 (Clifton Boulevard), take this until a roundabout, taking the first exit onto Lenton Lane.

Stay on Lenton Lane right to the end, turning right into the venue, where staff will guide you to the parking area.

The Riverside Golf Centre is not part of the Tour venue.

Local Transport

The Grove Farm playing fields themselves are best accessed by car.

However, if travelling by taxi or bus, the venue's nearest landmark is the Powerleague football pitches on Thane Road (NG7 2TG). When arriving at Powerleague, head straight across its car park and you'll find yourself on the northern end of the tournament's pitches. The marquees will be clearly visible from this point, and you'll find the TD Desk within these.

Please do not park in the Powerleague car park- it is for patrons of that facility only, and you may be clamped. There is plenty of parking available at the site itself.

Buses

Two bus routes serve the Powerleague site: **Citylink 1**, and **W4**. Both show 'Boots (Beeston)' as their destination, and can be caught from Nottingham Railway Station.

Citylink 1 is a park and ride bus, and looks like the bus below. It operates from 0600-1930, costing £3. Please note this service does not run on Sundays.

On Sundays, no bus routes directly serve the site. The nearest bus stop is a 5 minute walk from the Powerleague venue. From Nottingham Railway Station, take service **48**; a Navy blue bus, to 'Clifton Bridge North'. On disembarking, cross the roundabout towards Lenton Lane, and access the site via the Powerleague entrance. This route runs every half an hour.
