Directions: Follow signs to Heriot-Watt University.

Parking: There is a fairly large car park right in front of the venue (Oriam car park) as well as an overflow parking near the entrance to the university campus (Car Park A). If you park in car park A please use the zebra crossings to cross over to the venue.

Toilets and shower rooms will be open but please be aware that these are Oriam showers so are open to the public.

Arrival: Please report to the TD desk on arrival to receive any new instructions or any changes to this information. There will not be a separate captain's meeting, but every team should make sure that a representative checks in on arrival. If you don't, don't blame us when you don't know what's going on!

Gear: Don't take all your stuff into the playing area, and certainly don't leave it on the edges of the pitch as bags on sidelines can be very dangerous. Please use the viewing area/ stand to store your belongings.

Times: Games will run from approx. 11.30am to 7.30pm on Saturday, and from 9am to 5pm on Sunday.

Paper and Printing

We DON'T intend to print out schedules and copies of this pack for every team. Please make sure you bring your own (or ensure you can access it through your phone) if you need a copy. There will be a large up to date copy at the TD desk throughout the weekend of course.

Safety

Please remember that it is never worth endangering yourself or others to get the disc. Walls and floors are hard, and your body will not react well to crashing into them at speed. Please do remain aware of other players and your surroundings.

Food and Drink

There is a café on site serving both hot and cold food as well as a selection of drinks. It is open 9am to 5pm at weekends. There are vending machines selling drinks and small snacks within Oriam. There is a student shop in main University building (less than a 10 minute walk from the venue). Open from 10am to 9pm. Water will be available from multiple water fountains near changing rooms.

Do NOT take food or drink, other than water in a properly sealed container, onto the pitches. The viewing area/stand can be used to eat food you have brought with you.

Accommodation

We believe Aberdeen are the only team coming on Friday night and will be contacted separately.

For everyone else arriving on Saturday morning, we'll put you in touch with your hosts during the day of course – please ask at the desk.
