GB JUNIOR CODE OF CONDUCT

We have decided to take an extra precautionary step with our Junior players who are in the U20 teams, but are over 18 therefore, legally adults, but may be in receipt of financial assistance to help with payments for GB training and World/European Championships.

This extra step is to ensure that no player can run up a debt, or get themselves into a financial situation that they cannot handle.

If you are in receipt of financial assistance to help pay with any of the costs involved with training and competing for GB Ultimate, then a parent or guardian must read, understand and sign this letter alongside you, the player.

A parent/guardians signature on this letter indicates to the UKU that they fully understand the financial implications they are agreeing to, and the Code of Conduct attached.

A breach of the Code of Conduct could result in financial implications over and above that of the training/tournament costs, and as such this must be fully understood and agreed to before proceeding.
