

University Mixed Eligibility Criteria 2011/2012

This document outlines the criteria that must be met for a University Mixed team to select a player who is not a student at their institution.

Pick-up refers to the player who is playing for a university that they do not attend.

The University refers to the university that is playing with a pick-up.

The *pick-up(s)*

- **Either:** their institution is not entering a team in the event,
- **Or:** they have not been selected for any teams being entered.
- All *pick-ups* from one institution have to play for the same institution.

The University

- Must have already invited **all** players at their institution to play, regardless of skill or experience.
- Must invite **all** players at the *pick-up's* institution (**male and female**) to play, regardless of skill or experience.
- Must put the *pick-up(s)* on the highest-numbered team they have entered in the competition.

Geography

- This will be decided on a case-by-case basis, however
- *The University* and the university of the *pick-up(s)* **must** be in the same region.
- *The University* must be one of the *pick-up's* geographically nearest universities.

Notification of the UKU

- **By the penultimate Friday before any competition (ie the 1st for a competition held on the 9th/10th) *the University* has to have contacted the University Mixed Coordinator, Hayley Summers (unimixedcoordinator@gmail.com), if anybody is playing on their team who does not attend the institution full-time, along with full details of how and why they are eligible.**
- **For Regional competitions you will receive an email by the following Wednesday confirming their eligibility, it is recommended you print this email and take it to the competition.**
- **For National competitions you will received a completed eligibility form by the following Wednesday which you must print and hand to the TD when you complete a team sheet.**
- **If you have not been contacted by the Mixed Coordinator by Wednesday then please contact the University Coordinator, Edd Carmichael, immediately.**
