Address: The Edge Sports Centre, Willow Terrace Road, Leeds, LS2 9JT

Directions/Parking:

Please be aware that the university no longer offers free parking in on-campus car parks on weekends. The main car parks costs £1 per hour, with the first 3 hours free via a code, which you can receive from the Edge reception. To access these, enter the campus via the address shown above, and park either outside the edge, or turn right onto vernon road as soon as you enter campus for the multi-story.

Otherwise, free on-road parking can be found by entering the campus at the Clarendon Road/University Road or the Mount Preston St. entrances. Setting a sat-nav to **LS2 9JY** will guide you to the correct area. Park on Mount Preston St. or any of the streets from Lyddon Terrace to Cromer Terrace, then make your way on foot across campus to The Edge. The easiest way is to follow Mount Preston St and enter the University near the 'Staff Centre' and follow the path across the courtyard, down a ramp past the Roger Stevens Building and then past the rock pool. Follow the path to the right around the pool, eventually turning left down a small set of stairs. The Edge will be visible from there.

Arrival: Please report to the TD desk on arrival to receive any new instructions or any changes to this information. There will not be a separate captain's meeting, but every team should make sure that a representative checks in on arrival. If you don't, don't blame us when you don't know what's going on!

Gear: Don't take all your stuff into the playing area, and certainly don't leave it on the edges of the pitch. Bags on sidelines are dangerous! There is plenty of space for bags up on the balcony.

Times: Games will run from approx. 9am to 8pm on Saturday, and from 9am to 5pm on Sunday.

Paper and Printing

We DON'T intend to print out schedules and copies of this pack for every team. Please make sure you bring your own (or ensure you can access it through your phone) if you need a copy. There will be a large up to date copy at the TD desk throughout the weekend of course.

Safety

Please remember that it is never worth endangering yourself or others to get the disc. Walls and floors are hard, and your body will not react well to crashing into them at speed. Please do remain aware of other players and your surroundings.

Food and Drink

There is a small cafe in the Edge to purchase refreshments. The Union is located on Lifton Place and has a reasonably sized shop called Essentials in the downstairs area if you want to purchase food/drink. There are also small Tescos close by, one on Woodhouse Lane opposite the main University entrance (Parkinson Building) and one at the roundabout at the end of Willow Terrace Road (closest - if you walk straight out of the edge up the ramp/steps and walk over the bridge, it's on the left).

There is a water fountain outside of Hall 1. All the changing room taps produce drinkable water.

Do NOT take food or drink into the hall itself, other than water in a properly sealed container.
